RESPONSIBILITIES

- Conducts performance tuning of indexes and databases, and reviews database design and integration of systems
- Articulates backup recovery and makes recommendations regarding enhancements and/or improvements
- Maintains security and integrity controls
- Formulates policies, procedures, and standards relating to database management, and monitors transaction activity and utilization
- Develops stored procedures and/or triggers where applicable
- Administer database environments for the development, test, stage, and production environments
- Assists the technical solutions team with testing and implementing technical enhancements to the site, tools for task tracking, version control, and other operational support areas
- Develops code for new functionality, enhancements, and maintenance
- Serves as liaison with other Program technical organizations regarding database implementation, execution, sustainment, and improvements
- Works with data modelers on physical data modeling and updates physical data models based on logical model changes
- Works with other DBAs to implement physical data models in database. Synchronizes physical data model and database implementation
